### **UNIFORM UPDATE**

We are very pleased with the quality and the roll out of the new uniforms for our Nunawading Spectres Representative programs. We hope you like them too.

#### FOR BOYS TEAMS ONLY

Unfortunately the boys training shorts were missing our Spectres logo. This is going to be rectified on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> February (this Sunday) between 7.45am and 1.00pm in the conference room at Nunawading. (Where you pay your fees) What you need to do:

- Bring your shorts either before or after training and have the logo applied. (please make sure they are named)
- If you cannot attend training on Sunday you <u>MUST</u> arrange for either your team manager or another parent to do this on your behalf.
- Failure to have this done on the Sunday will mean that you will have to make arrangements and drive to Fitzroy to get the logo applied.

#### UNIFORM STANDARDS—ALL PLAYERS

It was great to see all of our players wearing their new Spectres uniform with pride over the Tournament weekend. We had so many positive comments from families and opposition clubs. Just a few things to take note of:

The uniforms must be worn as they have been intended.

- There should be no rolling up of shorts—the girls shorts have been made shorter so there is no need to roll them up to make them even shorter.
- The girls playing singlet has been designed specifically so that singlets do not and should not be tucked in.
- The wearing of skins under the playing uniform during games, the skins need to be out of sight and no longer than the players playing shorts.

Please do not make modifications to any of the uniforms. No screen printing is to be applied to warm up tops.

We want all players to look the same when you are out and about representing our great club.

Committee members will be out making sure that players are wearing the correct uniform.

\*also remember that when you are playing your domestic games, you are representing that club on that day. Please make sure you wear your domestic colours to those games and trainings.
