



NUNAWADING JUNIOR SPECTRES UNIFORM POLICY

ALL SPECTRES PLAYERS, both playing and Training, MUST BE IN FULL UNIFORM **AT ALL TIMES** WHEN REPRESENTING THE PROGRAM. THIS INCLUDES PLAYING UNIFORM AND WARM UP TOP AT ALL GAMES. NO STREET WEAR OR OTHER SPECTRES GEAR/SUPPORTER WEAR IS TO BE WORN TO GAMES OR TRAINING.

If players are not in correct full uniform they cannot take to the court to train or play.

Playing uniforms are only to be worn in games where the player is representing Nunawading Junior Spectres and are not to be worn in any other game or tournament without written approval from the Junior Spectres Committee.

Players are encouraged to follow the uniform policy of their respective domestic clubs and schools when wearing non playing Spectres branded clothing (eg: hoodies, polo shirts etc.)

The following sets out the uniform kit that is compulsory for each player representing Nunawading Junior Spectres.

The uniform Coordinator will supply the Team Manager an alternate clash set of white tops for players to wear at games when required during the season.

Its is a requirement that all Spectres players under 14 to under 18 own a foam or a firm roller. Under 12 players are NOT required to have a foam or firm roller.
